

FAME CASTING

AGENCY TERMS & CONDITIONS

All artists must read the below Terms & Conditions. By submitting an application artists confirm their understanding and acceptance of these Terms & Conditions between themselves and Fame Casting.

Hereafter, Fame Casting will be referred to as the Agency, the artist will be referred to as the Artist and the term Assignment(s) will refer to any work, assignment, audition or casting arranged by the Agency.

1. The Artist agrees that by submitting an application to be registered as with the Agency the Artist agrees to be bound by these Terms & Conditions
2. The Artist agrees that the Agency will to act as your agent in finding you bookings as an extra, background artiste, walk-on artist, or other similar work (referred to as "**Assignment(s)**")with production companies in accordance with this agreement.
3. The Agency agrees to represent the Artist but cannot guarantee that the Artist will receive Assignment(s) as ultimately the final casting decision rests with the clients and not the Agency.
4. The Artist agrees that the Agency may publish the Artist's details (including photographs) on the Agency website and forward the Artist's details (including photographs) to any clients of the Agency.
5. The Artist agrees that they are legally entitled to work in the UK. The Artist agrees that the Agency is unable to forward the Artist for any Assignment(s) until the Agency has received a photocopy of your passport or permit to work in the UK and your National Insurance Number.
6. The Artist understands that any Television Assignment (s) can start as early as 7.00am and last for up to twelve hours. The Artist understands that travel arrangements and expenses are the responsibility of the Artist and not of the Agency.
7. The Artist agrees to be professional and courteous at all times whilst undertaking any Assignment(s) and during all communication with the Agency and Agency staff.
8. The Artist agrees that the Agency has the right to terminate this agreement and it's representation of the Artist with immediate effect should the Artist, or any person accompanying the Artist fail to behave in a professional and courteous manner at all times on Assignment(s) or should the Artist fail to attend a pre-arranged Assignment(s) without notifying the agency.
9. The Artist agrees that failure to attend a confirmed Assignment(s) could result in the Artist being liable for the costs of that Assignment(s) unless you can provide a medical note from your Doctor.
10. The Artist has the right to terminate this agreement by giving 30 days written notice. However, the Artist cannot terminate this agreement, and will remain under contract with the Agency, if undertaking an ongoing Assignment(s) until the completion of that Assignment(s) or any associated Assignment(s) in full. The Artist agrees to complete any Assignment(s) with the Agency that has been started in any form, verbally/written/email etc, and may not continue this Assignment(s) with a different agent/agency or by self or any other form of representation.
11. The Artist agrees that the Agency acts as an employment agency and grants the Agency sole authority to collect, on behalf of the Artist all gross income arising from any Assignment(s) negotiated by the Agency throughout the term.
12. The Artist agrees that a commission rate of 20% will be deducted by the Agency from the gross fee for the Assignment(s) and that a charge of £1.00 per payment issued is applicable. No refunds or rebates are payable on commission fees.

13. Associates of the Artist who undertake work on behalf of the Agency agree that a commission rate of 20% will be deducted by the Agency from the gross fee for the Assignment(s) and that a charge of £1.00 per payment issued is applicable.
14. The Artist understands that they are self-employed and solely responsible for any payments of Tax and National Insurance, if applicable, that may be due and this is not the responsibility of the Agency.
15. The Artist recognises and agrees that the Client is the employer therefore payment for an Assignment(s) can only be made to the Artist on receipt of payment from the client to the Agency. The Agency cannot be held responsible for payment of monies owed to the Artist by the client if the client goes into liquidation or withholds payments from the Agency for any reason.
16. The Artist understands that it can take up to 90 days for The Agency to receive payment from the Client. Once payment has been received and cleared monies will be then paid into the Agency client account and will be forwarded to The Artist within 28 days.
17. The Artist agrees to ensure that bank account details are correct and kept up to date as the Agency will make payments to the Artist by BACS to this account. The Agency is not responsible for retrieving any payments made to the latest bank account details the Artist has provided.
18. The Artist agrees that if the Artist receives any fees directly from the production company The Agency is entitled to invoice the Artist for outstanding commission.
19. The Artist agrees that during the period of Agreement and thereafter in perpetuity, all fees arising from contracts, including renewed and or re-negotiated contracts originally arranged by the Agency on behalf of the Artist shall continue to be received by The Agency in accordance with the terms above.
20. Under the Data Protection Act 1998, The Agency are the data controller of all your details we hold. The Agency will use Artists details only for purposes related to this agreement, or as agreed by the Artist or permitted by law.
21. The Data Protection Act requires The Agency to obtain the Artists permission to share personal data with third parties. The Artist agrees that by signing this Agreement you are granting your full permission.
22. The Artist agrees that it is the responsibility of the Artist to notify the Agency of any changes to their personal details including (but not limited to) change of address, change of email address, change of telephone numbers.
23. The Artist agrees that it is the responsibility of the Artist to notify the Agency of any significant changes to their appearance to include (but not limited to) change of hair style/colour, change of measurements, addition of a tattoo or piercing.
24. The Artist agrees that failure to inform the Agency of any changes in the Artists appearance may result in being sent home from a booking without payment.
25. The Artist agrees that any details regarding any Assignment(s) undertaken by the Artist shall remain confidential and will not be divulged to the press/radio nor any other media nor posted on any social networking site or public forum. The Artist understands and agrees that details can include (but are not limited to) filming locations, storyline content, script content and information about any member of the cast and crew.
26. The Artist agrees that it is not the responsibility of the Agency to ensure the Artist's safety whilst undertaking any Assignment(s). The Artist agrees to comply with the rules and regulations, including those pertaining to Health & Safety that are in place at any premises or location where any Assignment(s) are undertaken.
